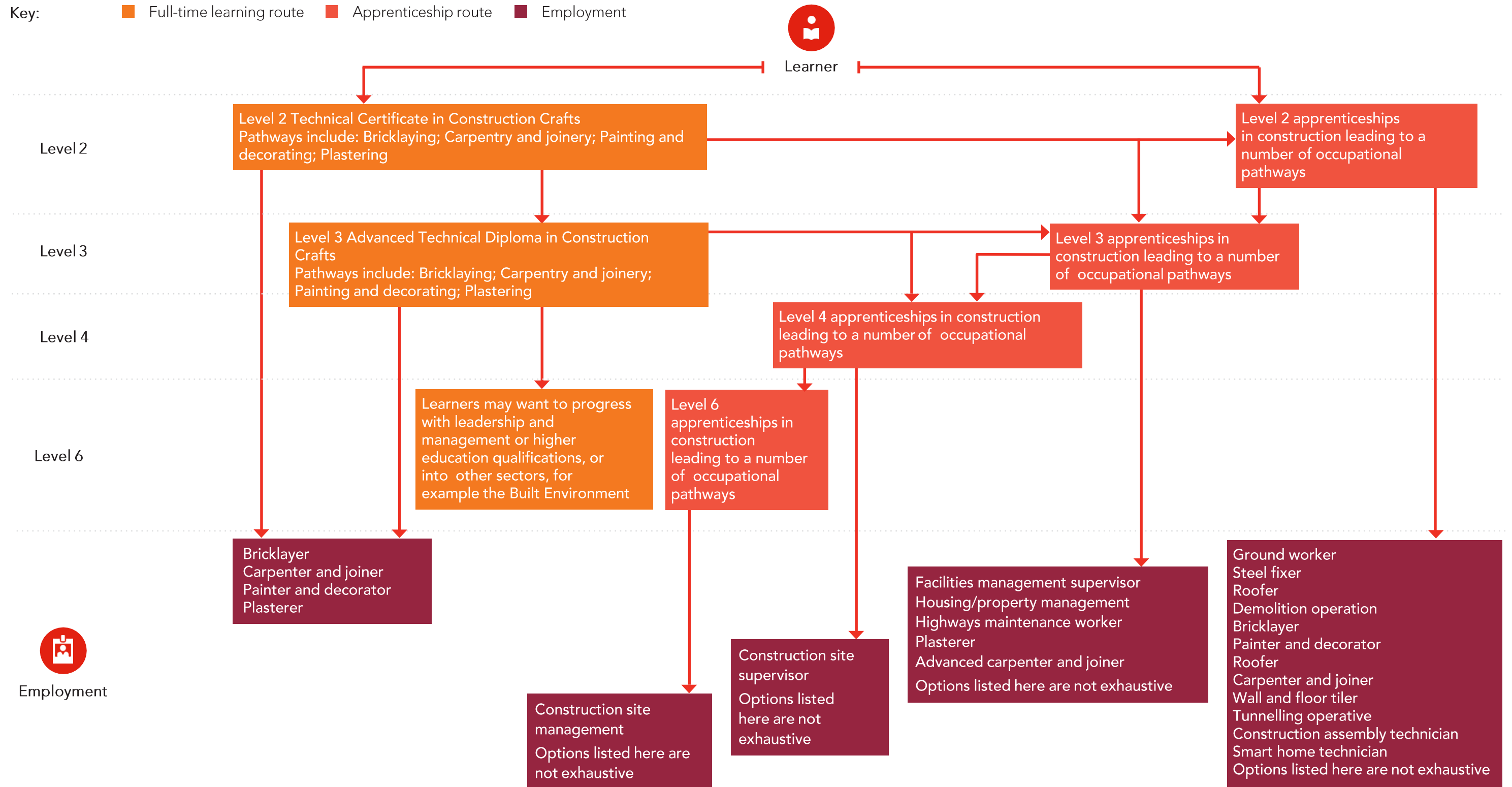


Your career in construction (craft sector) starts here

Learners can choose between Technical Qualifications and apprenticeships which can progress into meaningful employment or leadership and management roles.

Requirements: Centres will state their own entry requirements depending on level of attainment achieved. Level 1 full-time programmes are available for those not meeting entry requirements. We strongly advise learners to contact their preferred university or college for details on courses and entry requirements.

Please note that most principal contractors and major house builders require construction workers to hold a valid CSCS card, which can only be gained through an apprenticeship or employer sponsored qualification.
