Learner registration requirements

As of 1 September 2021, the registration window for the Wave 2 Construction TQs has been open. There are a few steps that should be followed to ensure that registrations and bookings are made correctly and in line with the expectations of the Institute and City & Guilds. Please see below the sequence that should be followed:

Registration: 1 September to 1 November 2021 (after this date, late and very late fees will apply- please see more information on fees [here](#)).



Step 1: Register for the core component of the TQ through the Walled Garden.



Step 2: Register for the occupational specialism through Walled Garden (this can be done at the same time as the core or as a separate transaction or later in the programme but importantly, you should not register for an occupational specialism before registering for the core).

When registering for the core and occupational specialism, please also remember to **provide the learner ULN**, as this is mandatory information that will be required in order to indicate which learners have passed their TQ with City & Guilds.

The booking (entry) window for the exam papers and the Employer-Set Project opens in January 2022.

New Industry Placement Cards for T Level Construction learners

To support learners on their T Level journey, which includes 315 hours of meaningful industry placement, Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) has introduced new Industry Placement Cards.

The new Industry Placement Cards are now available for learners aged 16 or above and registered onto a course requiring extended periods of work placement (minimum of 30 days, including T Levels), leading to a job in construction and the built environment. The industry placement card will enable learners to access the on-site experience they need to progress through their course, to completion.

It's important to apply to the card scheme relevant to the construction pathway undertaken by the learner.
